Our commitment

Digie B.V. understands that your personal data is important you. Hence, protecting your personal information, and complying with relevant data protection legislation, is something Digie B.V. takes very seriously.

What is the scope of this cookie policy?

In this document we want to inform you on the use of cookies on the websites of Digie B.V.. This concerns, more specifically, the use of cookies on the domain of www.digie.expert.

What is a cookie?

Cookies, pixel tags and similar technologies (collectively 'cookies') are small text files, containing small amounts of information. When you visit a website, they are (automatically) stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. They do not harm your computer, and do not contain viruses.

What purpose do we use cookies for?

Like many companies, we use cookies in different places on our website(s) to collect information that helps us enhance your experience and our services. On our website(s) we use cookies in different places, for instance, in order to help you navigate our website(s) and track your user session.

How can I control or delete cookies?

Most browsers automatically accept cookies. Nonetheless, you can disable cookies, delete cookies that have been accepted or have your browser notify you every time a cookie is set through the settings of your browser or by using a cookie management tool. Please note that you may not be able to use all functions of our website(s) if you disable cookies entirely.

What cookies do we use?

Google analytics

Digie website(s) make use of Google Analytics to analyse how you are using our website(s), and how, based on that, we can optimize our website(s). Google might share this information with third parties, should they be obliged to do so. We have no influence on that. All the information Google collects will be anonymised, as far as possible, and your IP address will not be included. Everything is saved on servers in the United States. Google claims to be compliant with the Privacy Shield principles and participates in the Privacy Shield – program of the United States Department of Commerce. This means, that there are appropriate measures in place concerning the (eventual) processing of personal data.
